OFFICE ORDER

Consolidated Revised Guidelines on the measures to be taken by Ministries / Departments of Government of India, State / UT Governments and State / UT authorities for containment of COVID-19 in the country - Regarding.

In continuation of the precautionary measures required to be taken to contain the spread of Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19) issued vide Order dated 15th April, 2020 (available on website), The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has extended the lockdown for a further period of two weeks from 04.05.2020 vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-I(A) dated 1st May, 2020 (copy enclosed) and accordingly it is for compliance by all Offices/Institutes/Units under Central Silk Board. The instructions regarding classification of areas into identification of Red (Hotspot), Green and Orange Zones should be updated as per the classification by the Ministry of Home and Family Welfare (MoHFW) which is dynamic and instructions in case of change of a zone from one category to another should be followed. The status as on 30.4.2020 is attached vide MoHFW, DO.No.Z.28015/19/2020-EMR dated 30-4-2020. Instruction regarding operation of Containment Zones and 100% coverage of Aarogya Setu app among the Office Staff should be complied with. Wearing of face mask is compulsory in Office and provision for disinfection of premises, thermal scanning, hand wash sanitizers as indicated in Annexure-I to the Order dated 01.05.2020 (ibid) should be continued. Care should be taken to ensure that no offence is committed against the provisions of Disaster Management Act, 2005 as per Annexure-II to the Order dated 01.05.2020 (ibid). Other instructions as per Order dated 15th April, 2020 should be continued. The Officers & Staff who are not included in the Duty Roster shall work from home and be available on mobile/telephone/electronic means and if required report for duty in exigencies except in cases of 'Quarantine' or areas in 'Containment Zones'.

The Director/Officer-in-Charge may also comply with Orders issued by the State Govt/Union Territory issued from time to time.

Whereas under directions of the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), guidelines on lockdown measures to contain the spread of COVID-19 in all parts of the country were issued vide Order of even number dated 24.03.2020 under the Disaster Management Act 2005 for a period of 21 days with effect from 25.03.2020. Under further directions of NDMA, the lockdown period was extended upto 03.05.2020 vide Order of even number dated 14.04.2020 and consolidated revised guidelines were issued vide Order of even number dated 15.04.2020;

Whereas in exercise of the powers under section 6(2)(i) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, NDMA has issued an Order number 1-29/2020-PP dated 01.05.2020 directing the Chairperson, NEC that lockdown measures be continued to be implemented in all parts of the Country, for a further period of two weeks with effect from 04.05.2020;

Whereas under directions of the aforesaid Order of NDMA dated 01.05.2020, and in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 10(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, NEC, hereby issues directions to all the Ministries/ Departments of Government of India, State/Union Territory Governments and State/Union Territory Authorities that the lockdown period is extended for a further period of two weeks with effect from 04.05.2020;

Whereas, in exercise of the powers, conferred under Section 10(2)(I) of the Disaster Management Act, 2005, the undersigned, in his capacity as Chairperson, NEC, hereby issues new guidelines on lockdown measures, as annexed, which will come into effect from 04.05.2020 for a period of two weeks, for strict implementation.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Effective use of 'Aarogyasetu' App for breaking the chain of transmission of COVID-19.

With reference to the subject mentioned above, the following directions may strictly be followed to improve the safety of all Government officials:

- (i) All the officers, staff (including outsourced staff) working in Central Government should download 'Aarogyasetu' App on their mobile phones, immediately.
- Before starting for office, they must review their status on 'Aarogyasetu' and (ii) commute only when the app shows 'safe' or 'low risk' status.
- 20/4 (iv) The officers/staff are advised that in case the App shows a message that he/she has a 'moderate' or 'high risk' calculated on the basis of Bluetooth proximity ("recent contact with infected person"), he/she should not come to office and self isolate for 14 days or till the status becomes 'safe' or 'low risk'.
 - Joint Secretary (Administration) should ensure that above directions are strictly followed in the respective Ministry/Department.
 - instructions Ministries/Departments similar may issue autonomous/statutory bodies, PSUs etc. attached to them.
